eliminated by the Commission.

Then there was a motion by Mr. Bond seconded and rejected by a vote of nine to ten, that the Constitution provide that no more than one-half of the petitioners reside in Baltimore City or in any one county.

Then I think, I am not sure whether the previous motion had left the matter to be reconsidered by the Committee.

I raise the question now because apparently on the record the action of the Committee is contrary to what the action of the Commission was last time.

I wondered whether the Commission in making the change in Section 9 thought it was following the mandate of the Commission.

MR. GENTRY: We certainly did. We thought that it was the sense of the Commission that the one-half from any one county be -- if we had that wrong, this is wrong.

THE CHAIRMAN: All I am trying to get is whether this reflected the judgment of the Committee or
