were both handed to you in the envelope this morning.

Mr. Brooks says the bill was submitted to you this

morning, the report you had by mail.

(Discussion off the record.)

MR. SCANLAN: The reporter thought this was to be taken up at a later date and I think that explains his absence.

This is the Sixth Report of our Committee on Convention Procedures. Basically it is a report that urges the adoption of a proposed enabling act which if it was passed by the General Assembly which convenes next January, would form the statutory basis for the Constitutional Convention itself.

As indicated in the first page of the report itself, many of the matters, I would say the majority of the matters of substance embraced in the proposed bill have previously been considered by the Commission. We believe that the Commission's action on those previous reports have been reflected in the bill itself. Hopefully that's so.

The first section of the bill, of course,
