paid for. I wonder if it should not be in the bill heading.

MR. SCANLAN: I believe it provides for compensation of the delegates.

MR. BOND: I am talking about the cost of the special election particularly.

MR. BROOKS: This is the point I was suggesting be taken up as a special report not in this report by the Commission today because this is something that will have to be really drawn up and presented in a different bill from this and should go on to the Budget Department right now. I think it probably would be an appropriate item of business after the consideration of this report.

MR. BOND: Does everyone understand the point I make? There is no provision in the bill to provide for the expense of a special election. If we do it, we have to do it fast.

MR. SCANLAN: That is correct.
