2 MR. CLAGETT: That's why I say we better  
3 find out.

4 MR. CASE: There was some conversation at  
5 our table at lunch today there was no real authority  
6 to put that on the ballot. The whole thing is a nullity.  
7 Legislature has no right just to put something on the  
8 ballot.

9 MR. SCANLAN: I believe, however, that  
10 last objection by Mr. Case is one we wrestled with  
11 earlier and I think the Commission acted on that one.

12 MR. CASE: No question, the people have  
13 acted.

14 MR. CLAGETT: We are aware of that problem  
15 and have already overcome that one.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion of  
17 the title? If not, proceed.

18 MR. SCANLAN: Next is Section 1 of the  
19 bill. This section authorizes a special election of  
20 delegates to be held on June 6, 1967. The voters  
21 will be the legally qualified voters in each county of
