permit the municipality to prescribe any age. Ready?

All those in favor of the absolute minimum of twenty-one years of age for voting in municipal elections signify by saying aye. Contrary, no.

DR. BURDETTE: Do I understand you correctly?

I voted no on the ground I wanted to leave it to the municipality. I voted no correctly.

JUDGE ADKINS: I vote no too on that basis.

THE CHAIRMAN: Maybe we should do it again.

A vote age is the vote that minimum age is twenty-one,
a vote no would leave to the municipality the question
of whether to use age twenty-one, eighteen or twentysix. Those in favor signify by saying age. Contrary,
no. Let's have a show of hands. Ages. Noes. The
noes were louder than their numbers would justify.

The next question, I take it, would be the question of minimum residence in the legislative district. A vote aye means that -- first of all, a minimum residence in the state. Take that separately, six months. A vote aye means that the minimum residence of six months in the state is a requisite. A vote no
