MR. BOND: Yes.

THE CHAIRMAN: And subdistricts in the county?

DR. BURDETTE: Second.

MR. CASE: District.

THE CHAIRMAN: District. Is the motion seconded?

DR. BURDETTE: Second.

MR. BOND: My criment is I disagree with the Committee's conclusion that you get higher type candidates by having elections from the county as a whole. I think that if you have legislative districts in the county, you have a closer relationship between the voters and delegates and people might know the people who are running and I feel that by running from a legislative district, you get a higher quality and better type candidate because of the fact that it would take fewer votes to elect the man and also because!his neighbors and the people who are in close proximity with him in business and other pursuits would have some contact with him.
