2 THE CHAIRMAN: And subdistricts in the  
3 county?

4 DR. BURDETTE: Second.

5 MR. CASE: District.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: District. Is the motion  
7 seconded?

8 DR. BURDETTE: Second.

9 MR. BOND: My comment is I disagree with  
10 the Committee's conclusion that you get higher type  
11 candidates by having elections from the county as a  
12 whole. I think that if you have legislative districts  
13 in the county, you have a closer relationship between  
14 the voters and delegates and people might know the  
15 people who are running and I feel that by running from  
16 a legislative district, you get a higher quality and  
17 better type candidate because of the fact that it would  
18 take fewer votes to elect the man and also because his  
19 neighbors and the people who are in close proximity  
20 with him in business and other pursuits would have some  
21 contact with him.
