

1 the Court of Appeals held that the one year require-
2 ment which had previously been in the requirement did
3 not affect someone who wanted to run. It seems to me
4 we don't want to get in that same problem. I know there
5 were two cases, one in the Fourth Legislative District
6 of Baltimore City, I think one in Anne Arundel County,
7 if I am not mistaken. I would suggest that perhaps
8 a year residency or some term of residence should be
9 there to just avoid this problem.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: We will consider that separate
11 from the present motion.

12 MRS. BOTHE: Before I vote on the motion
13 on the floor, I would ask that Mr. Scanlan expand his
14 Committee's theory that a better selection would be
15 obtained on a countywide vote.

16 MR. SCANLAN: At the time this non-partisan
17 aspect of this special election was discussed, there
18 was an attempt, as I recall, to insure that by specific
19 statutory language which the Commission rejected. But
20 certainly in the discussions both in the Committee and
21 in the Commission at the time the matter was before it,
