every one agreed, I assume, I thought, or most of us agreed that it was hoped that the election would be truly non-partisan, that the Democratic and Republican Central Committees in a particular area and various civic groups such as League of Women Voters and other types of groups would attempt to agree upon or solicit a list of distinguished citizens of the area of the county to stand as delegates for the convention.

I think it is more difficult, I believe, to do that when -- it is easier for my county of Montgomery, entitled to 16 delegates, much easier to put together a list of 16 distinguished citizens if we could draw from the county as a whole without being confined to the artificial boundaries, they certainly are artificial, highly gerrymandered boundaries of the legislative districts as they now exist.

The reason for the legislative districts, as I recall it in the reapportionment bill, was to cut down the opportunity to have a countywide political machine dominate. I remember certainly our friends of the Eastern Shore gave this as a reason and I think it
