is a pretty good reason in that context but this is to be a non-partisan election. This is not a partisan election. Legislative districts were put in to curtail the power of political parties or political machines in political elections. They have no necessary applicability in this special type election which is to be a non-partisan election. I just think it is more difficult to draw a selective list of say 16 than it is to come up, less difficult to draw a list of 16 when you can draw from a county as a whole than it is to artificially chop it up seven, seven and two.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

MR. BROOKS: I think this is a real political problem for this Commission and the Commission ought to really, I think this is the ideal time to consider what its hopes are in regard to a constitutional convention. I would think it would be the Commission's interest to already be considering those persons in the various legislative districts and counties who might make good delegates and already begin encouraging such persons to consider running for delegates.
