and Fifteenth Districts who run the county where political are leaders/are going to have the money, not going to try to raise the money, contributors will not put in the money to mount an assault against the kind of a slate that I envision would be running from our county if it could run countywide. Therefore, I think the danger which you and Hrs. Bothe see thinking in terms of an election for House of Delegates and so on where it is meaningful to the politicians really disappears when you think of the context of this election.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

MRS. BOTHE: I know I have spoken to the point but I would like to call the Commission's attention to the figures which were sent out to all of us last week. Baltimore County apparently turned in about a 25 per cent vote against a constitution. I think this follows out what I was just saying. I don't think Mr. Eney or Mr. Case or Dr. Winslow would get elected at all if the county isn't districted.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?
