A vote in favor of the motion is a vote to require that all delegates, both county and city, run on the basis of residence in and election by legislation of districts.

A vote no is a vote in favor of the Committee's proposal. Ready for the question? All those in favor signify by show of hands. Contrary. Motion loses five to fifteen. Any further discussion of Section 1?

MR. CASE: Let the record show this is the last time I will support Scanlan with such fervor.

MR. SYKES: I assume the Committee and appropriate authority, when they come to fielding slates, will bear in mind the concern of Dr. Jenkins and the necessity for something of an antidote to an excessively blue ribbon character to any slate that is fielded if we have any intention of getting elected.

THE CHAIRMAN: I would echo that. I have never used the term blue ribbon because I don't believe that's what we want but I think we do want a fully qualified convention.

MRS. FREEDLANDER: Mr. Chairman, how did our recent vote affect the City of Baltimore?
