going back to 1867 though districts have been added whereas legislative districts in the counties are something new. I have heard Mrs. Freedlander's reasons for the support of her motion, I don't say they are without merit but they don't move me enough to want to depart from the Committee's report.

MR. BOND: I must confess I disagree with

Mrs. Freedlander again because I think the whole City of Baltimore, taking her as an example, I feel she could win in the Fifth Legislative District and I don't think she would have a chance if the ticket ran as a whole.

I do feel that that gives much more control to the people who have been interested in government over the years.

MR. SYKES: There is a real danger that if election is held in Baltimore City by districts, there are going to be some districts where the delegates will
