That is the possibility of single shooting which will -maybe triple or quadruple shooting -- 43 people to
vote for, this is bound to happen and it is not good.
This argument applies to the question just defeated as
well but the smaller the number of candidates, the
less possibility or less strength gained by a voter
restricting his vote to less than the full number that
he is entitled to vote for. It certainly is going to
be a more democratic selection with a fewer number of
people.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

JUDGE ADKINS: Would it be fair to ask

for a preliminary vote from members from Baltimore?

We don't have political bosses in my territory. I would

like to vote with the majority of the Baltimore group.

Could we have a preliminary vote from them?

THE CHAIRMAN: I don't know if you have to take a vote. You have the sense. I am not sure who are all the Baltimore residents. Mr. Sykes is, Mrs. Freedlander, Mr. Gentry, Mr. Mindel. Do you want to state your views?
