MR. SCANLAN: That would be perfectly 1 acceptable to the Committee. I suggest it. 2 HR. BROOKS: One additional question on 3 Section 1 has to do with the date of June 6, 167, we 4 determined before. Apparently there will be a city 5 election in Baltimore in May, 1967, and there had been 6 some recommendation by outside groups that this Commission 7 consider combining the election in the city, statewide 8 election, if it is to be a special election, on the 9 same day as city election, first to reduce part of the 10 expense of a special election and second if voting 11 machines are anticipated to be used, there may be a 12 problem of this following so closely on the city 13 election that the voting machines would still be tied 14 up. 15 MR. SCANLAN: There are several reasons 16 why that suggestion was not acceptable. One, if -- is 17 it May 6? 18 MR. BROOKS: We are trying to determine the 19 20 date. MR. SCANLAN: Sometime in May.
