qualifications of delegates and reads, of course,
that to be eligible as a delegate to the Convention a
person shall possess all of the qualifications for a

provision that he may also be a minister or preacher
of the Gospel, or of any religious creed or denomination.
Preachers of the Gospel are not held constitutionally
eligible to be members of the House of Delegates. They
