

1 Constitutional Convention. I believe Mr. Hargrove made  
2 a suggestion in connection with Section 1 that we  
3 ought to make it clear he doesn't have to have residence  
4 requirement. I think that's academic now because having  
5 adopted Section 1 as the Committee recommended it, every-  
6 body who was over twenty-one and had lived in the county  
7 or legislative district in the case of Baltimore for the  
8 required period would possess the necessary qualifica-  
9 tions for a seat in the House of Delegates. I don't  
10 think there is any need here to change the language as  
11 we have it now.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: What are the qualifications  
13 now that would be covered under Section 2?

14 MR. SCANLAN: Age.

15 MR. BROOKS: Section 9, Article 3, I believe.

16 MR. SCANLAN: Nine and 11, no minister or  
17 preacher of the Gospel would be barred.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Would you state what you  
19 understand to be the qualifications that would be  
20 covered under Section 2 as drafted?
