

1 Section 9 which is the provision of the Constitution
2 which now prescribes eligibility in the Senate and
3 House of Delegates, he has to be a resident, has to be
4 a citizen of the State of Maryland, and he would have
5 to have resided for three years next preceding the date
6 of his election in the county or in the case of Baltimore
7 City in the particular legislative district. He must
8 also be twenty-one years of age at the time of his
9 election. Also --

10 THE CHAIRMAN: That's it, isn't it?

11 MR. CASE: Members of the House or Senate
12 couldn't qualify.

13 MR. SCANLAN: By giving up their seat.

14 MR. CASE: That is right, would have to
15 resign their seat.

16 MR. SCANLAN: That is right.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: I am not sure whether they
18 could do that because the disqualification is the
19 term for which they are elected under the present
20 Constitution.
