office of profit or trust. That is the thing.

MR. SCANLAN: That is correct.

MRS. BOTHE: That's what I was going to ask. The question about holding an office of profit or trust or seat in the General Assembly, whether the Committee had resolved whether or not certain people holding various offices around the state would be eligible.

MR. SCANIAN: I believe we, not only the Committee, but the Commission wrestled with this specific problem. It was determined, I believe, an earlier Attorney General's opinion in connection with the prohibition --

General Assembly members and decided there was a prohibition in light of research done. We have not adequately determined at this point what other public officials can or cannot under the law be delegates.

MR. MILLER: Could we get an opinion from the Attoeney General?
