permanent registration of voters.

MR. SCANLAN: Could I ask a question? If we voted age to approve the municipality having the authority to establish a permanent registration of voters, would that include power to impose property qualifications?

THE CHAIRMAN: Yes, sir. We have already given them that power by the other votes. Those in favor signify by saying aye.

MR. CLACETT: What is this?

THE CHAIRMAN: Uniform system of registration for municipal elections. Vote aye means municipality has the power, vote no means legislature has power.

Aye. Contrary, no.

Show of hands on aye. Show of hands on no. Motion is carried fourteen to four.

On nomination of candidates a vote aye means municipality has the power, no the legislature has the power. Show of hands on aye. No. Eighteen to one in favor.
