

1 to oppose the bill because we have not prescribed the
2 usual oath that is dear to the hearts of every one of
3 them. Since it really doesn't make a great deal of
4 difference, I see no harm in keeping it in. You just
5 create the possible hazard that the passage of the
6 bill will be that much harder.

7 MR. CLAGETT: I think that is quite an
8 important point because we are getting labeled to
9 some extent as a blue ribbon committee anyway and here
10 is something that somebody can point to showing that
11 we are left wing-right wing liberal or something
12 other than what we are.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Ready for the question?
14 A vote aye is a vote in favor of deleting from the
15 section the requirement of an affidavit in the form
16 prescribed by Section 15 of Article 85(A). I take it
17 that deletion does not eliminate the requirement. In
18 other words, the motion is not, as I understand it, a
19 motion to require the section to state affirmatively
20 that the affidavit is not required.
