with this type thing, it is conceivable you might not have. It wouldn't be Baltimore City, I am sure.

MR. SCANLAN: Could we come back to Judge
Adkins' suggestion when we reach the question of filing
vacancies later?

JUDGE ADKINS: I am perfectly willing to leave it with the Committee and not press the Commission's time.

THE CHAIRMAN: Let's suspend discussion of it and talk about it when we talk about vacancies generally.

MR. HARGROVE: My other point which was

out of order at the time is probably in order now.

Perhaps there should be some provision for a date when candidates can withdraw and I don't know whether the Committee has or has not considered refunds of the in filing fee such as is present today/ the filing for candidates to the House of Delegates. My thought on that is that perhaps if you don't give a refund, you probably give some serious consideration before filing. Then for many reasons people could withdraw. It would
