make perhaps a more orderly election. It doesn't 1 2 appear to be here. I think perhaps it should. MR. SCANLAN: On the question of withdrawal 3 later on, we provide for the applicability of the 4 election laws generally. I believe that certainly the 5 intention would be that the withdrawal situation would 6 be covered by the usual period of time applicable in a 7 regular election. I don't know --8 9 MR. HARGROVE: I would think the election 10 laws, if you read the various election laws, it probably 11 could not do it unless you specifically state it. 12 I think each has periods of time, if we use these 13 dates, you are going to be in trouble. 14 THE CHAIRMAN: Will the Committee take it into consideration? 15 16 MR. SCANLAN: Yes. 17 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comment on 18 Section 3? 19 MR. MARTINEAU: One thing that I didn't 20 catch before, I am not sure whether I mentioned this 21 in the Committee or not.
