considers qualifications for the post?

JUDGE ADKINS: This will be expensive enough.

MR. SCANLAN: I didn't hear that and I have the feeling I didn't want to hear it. What did you say?

THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Michener asked whether you think or the Committee thinks it would be desirable to have an added requirement that each candidate publish a statement of perhaps a hundred words in length stating his qualifications.

MR. SCANLAN: No.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further question? Any further comment? Section 5?

MR. SCANLAN: Section 5 deals with the mechanics of election. I might as well read this.

Section 5 reads: And be it further enacted, that the names of all candidates for delegates to the said Convention in each county and in each legislative district of Baltimore City shall be printed on a paper ballot or on the ballot labels for voting machines, according to the current usage of the several political
