MR. HARGROVE: I might suggest that some provision should be made for drawing because this just leaves it to the Supervisor of Elections to make a drawing. I think it should be notification to candidates and a drawing in some place they can attend.

MR. SCANLAN: It is required to be in public.

MR. HARGROVE: That means nothing. I think notification should be given to the candidates as to the time and place of drawing because a public drawing is not much when you don't have anybody there but the Supervisor of Elections and a few people who operate his office. You must remember these offices are political offices and in Baltimore City particularly the placing of names on the ballot is an art. I think it would be the same thing here.

MR. SCANLAN: A day certain is specified,
May 2. It has to be a public drawing so the candidates
know the day, they know the place, and I assume would
be there.
