

1 THE CHAIRMAN: No, I don't think that's  
2 necessarily correct.

3 MR. GENTRY: That's what I got.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: There is a provision, for  
5 instance, that you must have a secret ballot and the  
6 municipality can't do away with it. It may have it by  
7 means of a paper ballot, not by voting machine, but it  
8 must be a secret ballot.

9 DR. BARD: Key word is insure.

10 MR. RUSSELL: We are to redraft Section 7.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: You are to redraft Section 7  
12 in light of comments and instructions and submit it  
13 again.

14 PROFESSOR ASPER: May I interject one  
15 comment? I am beginning to regret I ever put Section 7  
16 in. I think if we left it out entirely, the provision  
17 would remain exactly as it is now as far as municipal  
18 elections are concerned.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: You might come to that  
20 conclusion when you report it back.

21 MR. SAYRE: In view of this startling outcome
