untoward actions.

MR. MARTINEAU: I think this problem is answered by Section 2 saying to be eligible as a delegate to the Convention a person shall possess X qualifications. I think that this would necessarily apply to anybody whom the Governor would appoint or who would be elected by the Convention.

DR. BURDETTE: In that case you need eliminate the statement of the Governor. If you put it in the Governor and not the Convention, the implication is the Convention is not bound.

to the Governor because the word qualification is referring back to Section 2 doesn't necessarily mean --

THE CHAIRMAN: Section 2 is rewritten.

MR. CASE: I am not sure it does with respect

MR. CASE: I understand it is rewritten but it doesn't say anything about where the man comes from. That is contained in an entirely different act.

THE CHAIRMAN: That's what I mean, Section 2 as rewritten today would provide that he have a year's residence in the district from which he is elected.
