thereafter? This runs across the holidays, end of the year. Are you talking about four calendar months or four months in session? Wouldn't it be clearer if you put a date by which it had to adjourn, January 12 would be four months from the date.

MR. SCANLAN: That is intended. Would the word calendar coming between four and months meet your point?

DR. MICHENER: Yes, or you could say it shall adjourn by --

THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Michener's suggestion is to say it shall continue in session no later than January 12, 1968.

MR. SCANLAN: That is all right. That was intended and seems to be a little more clear. I think our Committee would accept that.

MR. GENTRY: If you remember, there was considerable sentiment for a provision that the length of the meeting be three months, a one-month extension permissible. I think to use, I myself would prefer to stick with the four month rather than a day limitation
