does not constitute Roberts Rules of Order. This is
only for the period when they are organizing. Once
they organize, they can adopt any rules they want. Which

brings us to another problem.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further questions?

MR. GENTRY: Just one short one. If you feel that the Governor's right to convene early is important, be careful which draft you use because the one I followed says the Governor may convene and the appendix draft says shall and the other says may.

THE CHAIRMAN: The appendix draft is the one to be used. The other is for the Committee's use.

MRS. BOTHE: I would move the amendment in the event they don't have a Constitution within four months that the recommendations of the Commission are automatically adopted.

MR. CLAGETT: Let's all second that one.

MR. GENTRY: Why wait four months?

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further questions? I would like to ask a question. Under this set-up you would in effect have two temporary chairmen. I wonder
