

1 THE CHAIRMAN: I take it you don't need the
2 word organized. You can say until it shall have elected
3 a President.

4 MR. SCANLAN: Let's say that.

5 DR. JENKINS: What happens in the event they
6 cannot get through with the Constitution in four months?
7 After all, this Commission is slightly behind schedule.
8 Is there any recourse for legislative action or should
9 there be --

10 MR. SCANLAN: I think in that case
11 unfortunately the Legislature will not be in session.

12 MR. CLAGETT: They could call a special
13 session.

14 MR. SCANLAN: Yes, by providing the Convention
15 can stay two more months.

16 DR. JENKINS: You can always cut off the
17 payroll.

18 MR. SCANLAN: This is a debatable question.
19 There are some who feel the Convention has practically
20 unlimited powers and once having convened can keep itself
21 in session so long as it wants.
