

1 MR. HOFF: It can't levy taxes and pay its  
2 own salary. There is an incentive to cut it off.

3 MR. SCANLAN: Yes, the Michigan experience  
4 suggests when the cash runs out, the convention goes home.

5 MR. CLAGETT: The practical answer is  
6 we will do just as we are doing now. You meet at night.  
7 until you get through.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further question?

9 MR. MILLER: The Convention could continue  
10 in session and also continue \$50 per diem.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: I think it is generally  
12 thought they would have no power to impose taxes.

13 MR. MILLER: In Section 9 we say payment of  
14 \$50 for each day of actual attendance.

15 MR. SCANLAN: That's also subject to the  
16 four-month limitation of Section 8.

17 MR. MILLER: It doesn't say so.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Wait until we come to  
19 Section 9. Any further questions on Section 8?

20 MR. MINDEL: I suggest we call him the  
21 presiding officer instead of President. Might refer to
