1 budget for its expenses.

In any event, the statute provides it shall not authorize total expenditures in excess of those provided in the budget for its expenses. Obviously the Legislature will have to appropriate funds for the Convention and these appropriations under this provision could not be exceeded by expenditures incurred under the authority of the Convention.

MR. BOND: I raise the question about appropriations. In the present Constitution there is provision for paying the Legislators. I am concerned about that. Take an extreme case. Suppose the Governor would not put in his budget moneys to carry on and provide for the Constitutional Convention and this law is passed as is. Is there any way or have you considered how it would be a self-starter or how do we get the money to provide not for election but the actual carrying on of the Convention?

MR. SCANLAN: Two ways. One, would be included in the budget or, two, it would be the subject matter of a supplemental appropriation bill.
