MR. BOND: Should we not prepare such an approach?

We have already taken up THE CHAIRMAN: with the present Governor the question of starting the preliminary discussions to include in the budget which is now in process of preparation an amount for the next Convention. We told him we would give him a more definite figure later but at the moment suggested to him that he use the sum of \$1,000,000. He indicated that the uniform practice has been and undoubtedly will be that the Bureau of the Budget will proceed in the usual course with preparation of the budget which means getting the requests of the various departments and so forth. This will be one of the items.

No final action will be taken. The day after the election the Governor elect moves in in this area and the Budget Bureau then begins reporting to him because it will be his budget.

If the Governor, whoever he may be, Governor elect, should decide not to put an appropriation into the budget, I don't believe there is any means by which
