be afraid that maybee this would be construed as compen-1 sation and that the application of that law to permit 2 reimbursement of expenses would be in addition. 3 MR. SCANLAN: Mr. Chairman, like yourself, 4 I am not sure whether there is such a law but I am 5 sure the intention of the Committee was to make \$50 per 6 diem compensation the exclusive compensation. That was 7 to be all that the delegate gets. I guess the answer 8 is we have to check the statutes. 9 THE CHAIRMAN: Wouldn't it be simpler to 10 make it clear in that statute whether or not there is 11 anything else and for matters of public relations also 12 to spell out that the \$50 is a per diem payment covering 13 compensation and expenses. 14 MR. SCANLAN: Yes, we could do it that way. 15 That creates other problems. 16 No more than this. MR. CLAGETT: 17 MR. SCANLAN: That might indicate you could 18
