MR. BOND: I guess the Committee considered what could be basically unfairness. People from Western Maryland and from the outer reaches in lower Eastern Shore actually their net compensation will be much, much less than those from metropolitan areas of Baltimore and Washington who commute. Has the Committee considered that and decided that there should be no travel allowance?

MR. SCANIAN: We considered that. There may be -- I think you overstate it -- rather minor inequities. Hopefully the delegates will remain in session and some will try to get back to their places of business. When you start giving a travel allowance, you get into further red tape and calculations. I concede that this provision might effect some minor inequities on those delegates who come from greater distances but in the interest of simplicity, we arrived at \$50.
