I guess we did. MR. SCANLAN: 1 MR. CLAGETT: We also discussed who we 2 were going to have as President. 3 MR. SCANLAN: Don't reveal our whole hand. 4 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further question on 5 this section? If not, move on to Section 10. 6 MR. SCANLAN: Section 10 provides for the 7 oath the delegates would have to take before entering 8 upon their duties. I believe in my dear friend here 9 we will find no objection to this simple oath. We 10 have eliminated all reference to the diety and divine 11 12 providence and other divine beings. THE CHAIRMAN: If she doesn't object to it, 13 14 I will. MRS. BOTHE: I will leave it to the Chairman. 15 Don't you object? MR.SCANLAN: 16 MRS. BOTHE: Actually I think it is 17 superfluous. I don't object to it. As a matter of 18 fact, Miscellaneous Provisions Corollttee is the one that 19 suggested a general constitutional oath very similar 20 in language. I don't particularl, see the necessity for 21
