

1 MR. SCANLAN: I guess we did.

2 MR. CLAGETT: We also discussed who we  
3 were going to have as President.

4 MR. SCANLAN: Don't reveal our whole hand.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further question on  
6 this section? If not, move on to Section 10.

7 MR. SCANLAN: Section 10 provides for the  
8 oath the delegates would have to take before entering  
9 upon their duties. I believe in my dear friend here  
10 we will find no objection to this simple oath. We  
11 have eliminated all reference to the diety and divine  
12 providence and other divine beings.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: If she doesn't object to it,  
14 I will.

15 MRS. BOTHE: I will leave it to the Chairman.
