is highly desirable. We would fill legislative vacancies.

I think it is a shame for the Governor to make appointments to Legislature on nomination of the State Central Committee of the party in power for three years.

THE CHAIRMAN: This is put in as a principle and not as a section. I take it in view of the action on the similar provision of the Committee on Elective Franchise, we don't need to act on this provision. Go shead.

MRS. FREEDLANDER: This could be eliminated.

DR. BARD: Vacancy in Legislature should be filled in such manner as provided by law or if no provision has been made by law for the filling of vacancies at the time such vacancy occurs by appointment by the Governor for the unexpired term, such appointment to be made of a person of the same political affiliation as the Delegate or Senator vacating the seat in question. That does leave out the present requirement which brings the State Central Committee into the picture as you will remember.

DR. BURDETTE: It leaves out something else.

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
