

1 THE CHAIRMAN: My recollection is that
2 the legislative article has no express provision that
3 sessions be public.

4 MR. SAYRE: That the journal be published.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: That's not being talked about
6 now. The question here is sessions.

7 MR. SAYRE: I was referring to Section 11
8 where we say shall keep a journal of the proceeding
9 and I thought we meant shall publish such a public journal.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: The suggestion went beyond
11 that. We were talking about sessions of the Convention.

12 MR. SAYRE: We may have a problem of space
13 and accommodations and everything else. How far are you
14 going to extend it?

15 MRS. FREEDLANDER: I would like to pick up
16 the second point Dr. Michener made. In Section 8 we
17 say the Governor shall convene a Convention and so
18 on for organization of the Convention for election of
19 members of committees for adoption of rules of order.
20 Why couldn't we just add these two items and do away
21 with these two sections?
