new Constitution for submittal to the voters of the state, et cetera, shall require a majority of the whole number of delegates to the Convention. I specifically recall Mr. Ridgely Melvin, former member of this Commission, new on the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County, was the author of that proposal.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any question? Discussion? Section 13.

MR. SCANLAN:

Section 13 prescribes how the

proposed new Constitution or changes or recommended proposed changes are to go to the people. Certified by the secretary of the State Board of Election Supervisors of the various political subdivisions and there will be a special referendum election on May 14, 1968. I might add parenthetically if by that time the new Legislature has moved the primary date back from September to May, usually I guess it is the first Tuesday in May, then I suppose there would be no real objection to changing that date to have this referendum election held on primary day much like the referendum on the call of the Convention was held on the primary, on the September 13
