

1 primary this year. The referendum will be conducted
2 pursuant to the general election laws except as we have
3 recommended modification or change in this act. I
4 think the rest of it is there for you to read. I won't
5 take up your time by reading it to you.

6 DR. JENKINS: Mr. Scanlan, how are the
7 people going to know what is in the Constitution?
8 It is unrealistic to provide for its publication in a
9 newspaper yet there is nothing here which says the
10 Convention is required to disseminate its final document.

11 MR. SCANLAN: Actually the Convention will
12 adjourn no later than January 12, 1968. Whereas the
13 referendum on its adoption or rejection would be con-
14 ducted five months later. Certainly we hope during
15 that period of time that people of the state will, one,
16 be interested enough to inform themselves as to what
17 is in it. It will receive a maximum degree of publicity.
18 I don't know what more one can do to guarantee that the
19 electorate will know they are going to be called to
20 vote on a Constitution.
