Is that what you have in mind? question. 1 DR. BURDETTE: Yes. 2 THE CHAIRMAN: It seems he has a point 3 that the language you use might prevent that. I don't 4 know whether you think it is desirable or not desirable, 5 only talking about the language you use. Whether you 6 intend it to be prevented or not. 7 I suggest to Mr. Scanlan MR. CLAGETT: 8 if he substituted for the word "it" in the third 9 sentence the two words "the matter" you have the cure. 10 THE CHAIRMAN: May I ask this. I think 11. what is implicit in Dr. Burdette's motion is language 12 which would say that the same shall be forthwith certified 13 by the Secretary of State to the Board of Election 14 Supervisors and so forth by whom it shall then be 15 submitted in the manner specified by the Convention, 16 if this is what the Committee means to recommend. 17 MR. SCANLAN: I don't think we did. I 18 think if the Convention wanted to submit separate 19 amendments, it could do so but hopefully it would submit 20

one document. We did not take into account, I don't
