Ready for the question? Question arises on the motion to amend Section 13 so as to provide that a new Constitution may be submitted in parts for the approval or rejection of the electorate as determined by the Convention. Ready for the question? Those in favor, please signify by show of hands. Contrary. Motion is lost four to fifteen. Any further discussion of Section 13?

MR. CASE: I have a point. I am not sure of my ground here so I will put it by way of question to the distinguished Chairman.

This particular section says in substance that the Convention can propose an amendment. Let's assume for purposes of discussion here that the only thing that the Convention feels it really wants to adopt are the budget amendments talked about this morning. I am using that only for purposes of illustration.
