Legislature. I don't think that ought to be permitted.

THE CHAIRMAN: Your point is whether the

vacancy is filled in manner provided by law or

filled by the Governor it should be filled only until the next election?

DR. BURDETTE: Yes, I would provide that the vacancy be filled by the Governor with a person from the same political party and the person should serve that party of the unexpired term terminating at the next general election.

MR. SMITH: Suppose it is only a week until the next general election?

DR. BURDETTE: Probably wouldn't appoint him.

MR. MINDEL: Suppose the vacancy occurs

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Mindel.

a week before the election. The answer was the Governor would probably hold off until after the election to make the appointment. He would serve until the next election.

DR. BURDETTE: You are right. I am trying to adopt exactly the situation we have in the United States

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
