DR. MICHENER: Your objection? 1 My objection to Mr. Case's MR. SCANLAN: 2 point? 3 To just specifying that they DR. MICHENER: 4 shall draw up a document, new Constitution, which would 5 imply they had power to do the lesser thing. 6 No, I am not so sure that's MR. SCANLAN: 7 If this Commission is to draft a complete 8 Constitution, then the argument can be made that they 9 are commissioned to do no other thing, that they must 10 draft a new Constitution or they draft nothing. 11 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further question or 12 comment? Any motions as to Section 13? 13 IR. CASE: You are convinced in your own 14 mind based upon the research that you and your Committee 15 have done that the Constitution can be amended in this 16 17 way? MR. SCANLAN: Let's put it this way. 18 matter how you cut it, the questions you have raised 19 relate to the skepticism that some have -- and you 20
