conventions would indicate that you cannot so restrict a constitutional convention. I would hate to see this bill attempt to do so.

DR. JENKINS: I am not a lawyer but it is very clear here, in the present Constitution, it says any constitution, two ways of submitting amendments, one, the normal way, one by constitutional convention. Any constitution or change or amendment of the existing constitution which may be adopted by such convention. It is quite clear that as Judge Adkins says, this law would not be, the proposed statute would not be overriding.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

Ready for the question? Question arises on the motion to amend Section 13 so as to eliminate any reference to change or amendment of the existing constitution. A vote aye is a vote in favor of eliminating those words.

All in favor, please signify by show of hands. Contrary. The motion is lost five to thirteen. Any further discussion of Section 13? Section 14.

MR. SCANLAN: Section 14 is that provision
