idea of preparing the results than it can at preparing a draft of the Constitution or the commentaries or the research papers or anything else we will present. We hope, as indicated in the discussion of the bill yesterday, that the Convention would convene in the early part of the summer for the purpose of electing the presiding officer and have him appoint committees and to enable the Members to begin their study of whatever materials they want to study, including, of course, the work of this Commission.

It would be most helpful, we think, if the officers, principal officers of the Convention, such as the parliamentarian could be appointed at that time and the Rules Committee could be appointed so that they could consider a draft of rules already presented and be able to move forward quickly. There are some slight disadvantages to preparing a draft, but we think the advantages far outweigh the disadvantages.

Let me add just one more comment. This is in no sense a make work project. We are on the reverse pedal on that now. Anything we don't have to do, we are not
