as the other provisions in the new Constitution regarding education. Now, there was considerable sentiment expressed that the, that not only should the budget provisions be retained but that the substance of Section 3 of Article VIII that the school fund be inviolate should also be retained in the new Constitution. Then there was sentiment expressed regarding the State Board of Education and the State Superintendent of Public Schools. There is no mention whatever made of them in the current Constitution, and there was some feeling that they should be recognized, and their means of selection placed in the Constitution. Third was that the University of Maryland and its Board of Regents be given constitutional recognition, and of course, that will be gone into with some debate, I think, this morning. It was also suggested, and I might say that the question of autonomy for the other institutions of higher learning of the State was not dealt with as
