11 ation of the Sections, and if any of the omitted matters
12 are not covered in the debate, you can decide then whether
13 you want a specific approval or disapproval.

14 MRS. BOTHE: I trust everyone has carefully
15 read the voluminous report distributed.

16 The Committee proposes that there be either
17 an Article or various Sections devoted to education in
18 the new Constitution and breaks down the recommendation
19 into three sections.
