the recommended Section 1?

MRS. FREEDLANDER: Yes, without the exhortation .
Some change of words in it.

THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Bard?

DR. BARD: Mr. Chairman, is it in order to comment not on the substitution of one section for another, but on the contents or let us say, the deletions, as I see it, in terms of both proposals, or is this out of order?

THE CHAIRMAN: No. no.

DR. BARD: Well, I would like to start the discussion by a question. I was present when there was a good deal of discussion in connection with Section 3 of Article VIII in the current Constitution, school fund of the State shall be kept inviolate and appropriated only to the purposes of education. Dr. Folin and a whole host of people involved in education in the State of Maryland and in the Counties of Maryland made it clear that this particular section was the one that made it possible for them to be able to depend upon the budget for their respective County school systems and the State school system.
